This Indenture made this sixteenth day of December in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred Sixty and Six Between Thomas Browning of Kent County Miller of the one part and James Dick and Thomas Richardson of the City of Annapolis Merchants of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the aforesaid Thomas Browning heretofore to wit on the Twenty Sixth Day of February in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred Sixty and five for and in Consideration of the Sum of Three hundred and Twenty five Pounds Sterling Money to him the said Thomas Browning by them the said James Dick and Thomas Richardson paid did by Deed of Mortgage under his hand and Seal Mortgage and pledge unto the said James Dick and Thomas Richardson All that Water Grist Mill having two pair of Stones one pair of which are French Burrs two Bolting Chests and all other Gaers and Appurtenances to the said Mill belonging or appertaining which the said Thomas Browning Purchased of a Certain David Wether spoon Standing on Swan Creek issuing out of Sassafras River and Twenty Acres of Land to the said Mill adjoining and which the said Thomas Browning heretofore on the Sixth day of November one thousand Seven hundred and Sixty four together with the Twenty Acres adjoining Mortgaged to Wriston Browning of Kent County for the Payment of one hundred Pounds Sterling Also all his remaining part of a Tract of Land called Browning's Discovery lying in Kent County aforesaid also forty six and one half Acres of Land which he purchased of a Certain Micajah Carman lying and being in Kent County aforesaid also that part of a Tract of Land lying and being in Kent County aforesaid called Mitchell's Chance which he purchased of a Certain William Stoops also fifty Acres of Land part of the aforesaid Tract called Mitchell's Chance which he purchased of a Certain Joseph Carman together with all rights Benefits &c. to the said Mill and Tracts of Land and parts of Tracts of Land aforesaid or either of them belonging or in any wise appertaining which said Mortgage according to an Express Condition or proviso in the same contained wants have been null and Void upon his the said Thomas Browning his heirs Executors or Administrators paying unto them the said James Dick and Thomas Richardson their Heirs and Assigns the full and just Sum of Three hundred and Twenty five Pounds Sterling Money at or upon the Twenty Sixth day of August next ensuing the date of the said Mortgage Together with legall Interest for the same to be Calculated and paid from Three Months after the Date of (said)
