 Evans of Prince Georges County in the Province of Maryland Planter son and heir  
 at Law of Thomas Evans late of the said County Deceased of the one part and  
 Richard Henderson of the same County and Province Merchant of the other  
 part Witnesseth that the said Walter Evans for and in Consideration of the Sum  
 of Three hundred and fifteen Pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain to him  
 in hand paid by the said Richard Henderson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 hath given granted Bargained and Sold Aliened Released Enfeoffed and Confirmed  
 and by these Presents he the said Walter Evans doth Give Grant Bargain and  
 Sell Alien Release Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said Richard Henderson his heirs  
 and Assigns All that part of a Tract or Parcel of Land lying and being in the County  
 aforesaid on the North side of the Eastern Branch of Potowmack River Originally  
 Granted to Andrew Clarke by the name of Nevers alias Nevers But now called France
