 now hath good right full power and lawfull authority to grant bargain

 tenances unto the said Francis Harris his heirs and Assigns in Manner
 aforesaid Provided always and it is the true intent and Meaning of these
 presents that if the said William Rooke his heirs Executors or Assigns
 shall well and truly Pay unto the aforesaid Francis Harris his heirs Executors or
 Assigns the full and just Sum of One hundred Fifty Seven pounds Eighteen
 Shillings and Six pence Pennsylvania Currency with Lawfull Interest from the
 first
