 or Assigns the sume and just sum of Eight hundred and sixty pounds five Shillings

 but if the said Several sums of Sterling Money last aforesaid with lawfull Interest
 shall not be paid on the respective Days and times above mentioned that then and
 from thenceforth it shall and may be lawfull to and for the said John Hale his
 Executors Administrators and Assigns on Failure of Payment of either of the above
 sums after three months notice in writing left at the Dwelling house of the Henry
 Hale absolutely to sell and convey away all and singular the said Tracts or Parcels
 of Land and Promises and every part and parcel thereof and the Surplus if any
 after the payment of the said Principal sums of Eight hundred and sixty
 pounds and five Shillings Sterling and Interest to be paid to the said Henry Hale and
 the said Henry Hale for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators doth hereby
 Covenant grant and agree to and with the said John Hale his Executors Administrators
 and Assigns that any Purchaser or Purchasers of the said Promises or
 any part thereof from or under him the said John Hale as aforesaid shall hold
 occupy possess and Enjoy the same free from any Interruption of him the said
 Henry Hale his heirs or Assigns and clear from all Incumbrances or claim of him
