 parcels or tracts of Land Situate, Lying and being in Calvert County aforesd the one
 call'd and known by the name of Watchholers Quarter, the other call'd and commonly
 known by the Name of Singans Adventure which foresd tracts of Land contain by
 estimation One thousand three hundred and fifty acres of Land more or less. Together
 with all manner of houses out houses ways waters watercourses woods Timber
 and Timber trees with all profits conditions and Advantages unto the said two
 tracts or parcels of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining) As also Negroes
 Cooper Hercules aged about twenty two years. Young Dick aged about
 Seventeen Sam aged nine months To him the said Thomas and his heirs for ever,
