 demand of me the said Thomas Singan or of any other person or persons what-
 = soever for me or authorized or procured by me and without any money or thing
 to be yielded unto me the said Thomas Singan my heires ettes Administrors or
 Assignes and I the said Thomas Singan all and Singular the aforesaid Lands
 goods Chattels and promises with their and either of their Appurtenances
 to the said Thomas Martha Ann and Elizabethe Singan Separately and
 respectively have given to them their heires and Assignes for ever to the use and
 intent aforesaid against all people do and will warrant and for ever defend
 by these presents and further know ye that I the said Thomas Singan have
 put the said Thomas Martha Ann and Elizabethe in peaceable and quiet
 possession of all and Singular the aforesaid promises with their Appurtenances
 to them ^{and Separately} respectively given and granted by the delivery unto each of them at the
 sealing and signing of these presents one certain piece of Silver commonly called six
