This Indenture made the Ninth Day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Seven Between John Baynes of Prince Georges County of the one part and Joseph Noble of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Baynes for and in Consideration of the Sum of Five Shillings to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Noble the Receipt whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge and himself therewith fully Satisfied & Contented And doth by these Presents Concede Acquit and Discharge him the said Joseph Noble his heirs Executors, Administrators and Assigns, hath given granted, Bargained aliened, Sold enclosed and confirmed, And by these Presents doth give Grant bargain, alien, Sell enclosed and confirm unto him the said Joseph Noble his heirs and Assigns for ever, all that part of a Parcel of Land called Joseph & Marthas Delight lying and being in the County aforesaid Together with all Privileges and Appurtenances therunto Belonging Beginning at the End of the first Line of the Original Tract and Running thence North Eight and three fourths of a Degree West sixty four and a half Perches which is to strike the End of the Thirteenth line of the Original Tract then Reversing the Course of the Thirteenth line ~~with the Thirteenth line~~ is South forty Degrees West Forty Perches to the End of the Twelfth line then with a straight line to the Beginning containing Five acres more or less To have and to hold to him the said Joseph Noble his heirs and Assigns and to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Joseph Noble his heirs and Assigns for ever And the said John Baynes doth for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators covenant and agree to and with the aforesaid Joseph Noble his heirs and Assigns that he the said John Baynes his heirs Executors and Administrators the aforesaid parcel of Land with the Promises and all the Appurtenances unto the aforesaid Joseph Noble his heirs and Assigns against all Persons Claiming by from or under him with Warrant and forever defend by these Presents In Witness whereof the party first mentioned hath put his hand and Affixed his Seal the Day & Year above Written
