to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Noble the Receipt whereof he doth hereby  
Acknowledege and himself therewith fully Satisfied & Contented and doth by these  
Presents Exonrate Acquit and Discharge him the said Joseph Noble his heirs  
Executors Administrators and Assigns. Bath given granted Bargained aliened Sold  
enfeoffed and confirmed. And by these Presents doth give grant bargain alien sell enfeoff  
and confirm unto him the said Joseph Noble his heirs and Assigns for ever all that  
part of a Parcell of Land Called Joseph & Marthas Delight lying and being in the  
County aforesaid Together with all Privileges and Appurtenances thereto Belonging  
Beginning at the End of the first Line of the Original Tract and running thence  
North eight and three fourths of a Degree West fifty four and a half Perches which  
is to strike the End of the Thirteenth line of the Original Tract then Reversing the Course  
of the Thirteenth line with the Thirteenth line and is South forty Degrees West Fifty  
Perches to the End of the Twentieth line then with a straight line to the Beginning  
Containing Two acres more or less to have and to hold to him the said Joseph Noble  
his heirs and Assigns and to and for his only proper use and Benefit of him the said Joseph  
Noble his heirs and Assigns for ever And the said John Baynes doth for himself his  
heirs Executors and Administrators covenant and agree to and with the aforesaid Joseph  
Noble his heirs and Assigns that he the said John Baynes his heirs Executors and  
Administrators the aforesaid parcell of Land with the Promises and all the Appur-  
tenances unto the aforesaid Joseph Noble his heirs and Assigns against all Persons  
Claiming by from or under him will Warrant and forever defend by these presents  
In Witness whereof the party first mentioned hath put his hand and affixed  
his Seal the Day & Year above written.
