

Indenture dated the ²¹ day next before the Day of the Date of these presents for our year from the Day next before the Day of the Date of these said Indentures in consideration of two Shillings Sterling to him in hand and by force of the Statute for transferring leases into possession and to his Heirs All that tract or parcel of Land called Ashlawn Hope Situate lying and being in Baltimore County aforesaid containing three hundred and twelve acres more and except so much thereof as is in the possession of a certain Thomas Harrison And his Reversion and Reversions Remainder and remainderers Rents Issues and Profits of all and singular the said Premises with its Rights Members and Appurtenances and all the Estate Right Title Interest claim and Demand of him the said George Aslunau of unto or out of the said hereby released premises with the Appurtenances and every part thereof To have and To hold the said Tract or parcel of Land except as before excepted and all and singular the members with the Appurtenances unto the said Robert Alexander his heirs and assigns To the intent and purpose that by virtue of the said Indenture of Bargain and Sale and of these present he the said Robert Alexander may be and become a good and perfect Tenant of the immediate Freehold and Inheritance of all and singular the said hereby released premises with their Appurtenances against whom a common Recovery may be had perfected and executed in such manner as is herein after mentioned And for that purpose it is covenaunted concluded and agreed by and between all the said parties to these presents that at the proper Costs and Charges of the said George Aslunau onerous of Entry our Process enforst shall on may be brought commenced or prosecuted returnable before his Lordships Justices of the Provincial Court to be held at Annapolis the third Tuesday of May next in the name of the said Joseph Nicholson as Plaintiff or plaintiff against the said Robert Alexander as Tenant wherein the said Joseph Nicholson shall demand against the said Robert Alexander the said Tract or parcel of Land except as before excepted with the Appurtenances by such act and convenient Rents and Description as shall be proper in that behalfe to which the said Robert Alexander shall appear gratis in his own person or by his Attorney or Attorneys lawfully authorized and shall and will vouch or call to Witness the same premises the said George Aslunau who shall appear gratis in his proper person or by Attorney lawfully authorized and shall and will enter into the said Warrant and vouch over to warrant the same premises the Common Voucher who shall theroupe apear and enter into the said Warrant and after Imparlement make Default and such further or other proceedings be had upon the said Writ and all the said parties shall be deemed themselves therein that one good and perfect common Recovery with double Voucher shall or may be had suffered perfected and executed of for or upon all and singular the said hereby released premises with their Appurtenances in all things according to the usual Course Order and Form of common Recoveries with double Voucher for Assurances of Land in such cases used and it is further covenaunted concluded declared and fully agreed by and between all the said parties to these presents for themselves and their Heirs and it is their true intent and meaning that the said common Recovery so as aforesaid or in any other
