This Indenture Made the Twenty Sixth Day of December in the Year of our Lord God One thousand seven hundred and Sixty five Between Samuel Scott of Prince Georges County in the Province of Maryland Carpenter of the one part and Thomas Beale of Prince Georges County in the Province Aforesaid Planter of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Scott for and in Consideration of the sum of Two hundred Pounds current money to me in hand paid by the said Thomas Beale at or before ye ensealing and Delivery of these Presents the Recou whereof he the said Samuel Scott doth hereby acknowledge and confess and himself to be fully Satisfy'd Contented and paid Math Gwin granted Bargained Sold Alsciened Infecoffe Released and Confirmed and by those Presents doth for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators fully clearly and absolutely give grant Bargain Sell Alsciened Infecoffe Released and Confirm unto him the said Thomas Beale his heirs Executors Administrators and Assignees all these several Tracts of Lands lying and being in Prince Georges County aforesaid That is to say, one Tract or parcole of Land called Dam Begining at a Bounded white oak in a Line of Niman Beales Land it being a Bounded Tree of Francis Risley and running with thosaid Beales Line North North East three hundred and Thirty Perches to a Bounded Kincry on the North Side of a great hill near a Branch called the Beaver Dam Branch then East South East One hundred and sixteen Perches to a —
