

This Indenture made the twenty first day of August anno  
Dominii 1767 By and between Thomas Green of Frederick County  
Planter of the one part and Jacob Waters of the said County mill  
wright of the other part witnesseth that the said Thomas Green  
for and in consideration of the sum of thirty five Pounds current  
Money of Maryland to him in hand paid by the said Jacob  
Waters before the sealing and delivery of these presents the  
receipt whereof the aforesaid Thomas Green doth hereby acknowledge  
and himself therewith fully satisfied and paid and doth Acquit  
exonerate and discharge the aforesaid Jacob Waters his heirs executors  
and Administrators hath Bargained and sold transferred and confirmed  
and by these presents doth bargain and sell transfer and confirm  
unto him the aforesaid Jacob Waters his heirs and assigns forever  
all that Tract of Land lying and being in Middle Sennar in  
Frederick County known and called by the name of SUSANNAH  
Beginning at a bounded white Oak standing near the head of a  
Branch and near the Spring and running from thence North forty  
five degrees West forty two perches South forty one Degrees West  
eighty four perches South forty eight East forty six perches South  
forty perches South thirty three Degrees West forty four perches  
North sixty nine Degrees East seventy nine perches then with a  
straight line to the Beginning Containing fifty Acres of Land  
more or less together with all Woods under Woods timber and timber  
trees Water and Water Courses free ingress and regress from and  
unto the same as also all profits privileges and Appurtenances  
whatsoever unto the said parcell of Land or any part thereof or  
in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the said land  
and all and singular the premises therein before mentioned  
or intended to be granted Bargained and sold and every part or  
parcell thereof with their and every rights members and Appurtenances  
unto the aforesaid Jacob Waters his heirs and assigns forever to the  
only use and behoof of the aforesaid Jacob Waters his heirs and assigns
