Vestrymen and Plumer James and Richard Burges Church Wardens being the Nector Vestrymen and Church Wardens of All Hallows Parish in Antrim County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the aforesaid Thomas Gasaway for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred and sixty four pounds seven shillings and six pence Sterling paid in Hand to him the said Thomas Gasaway at or before the sealing and Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Thomas Gasaway doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and therefrom and from every part and parcel thereof doth Acquit release exonerate and discharge the aforesaid David Love Nector and Henry Hall, Richard Williams Jun^r. William James Richard Watkins Lewis Lee Richard Beard Jun^r. Vestrymen and Plumer James and Richard Burges Church Wardens of All Hallows Parish aforesaid in Antrim County aforesaid and their successors and every of them by these presents hath granted Bargained sold Aliened Remised Released Conscuffed and Confirmed and by these presents Doth grant Bargain sell Alion Remise Release Conscuff and Confirm unto them the said David Love Nector and Henry Hall, Richard Williams Jun^r. William James Richard Watkins Lewis Lee Richard Beard Jun^r.
