This Indenture made this fifteenth Day of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty eight Between Charles Carroll of the City of Annapolis Esquire Barrister of the one part and Lancelot Jacques of the City of Annapolis Merchant and Thomas Johnson Junior of the City of Annapolis Attorney at Law of the other part Witnesseth that the said Charles Carroll for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred and ninety pounds Current Money of Pennsylvania to him in Hand paid at or before the Sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and therefrom doth release acquit and discharge the said Lancelot Jacques and Thomas Johnson Junr. their Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns and every of them by these presents Hath given granted bargained sold aliened released enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents Doth give grant bargain sell alien release enfeoff and confirm unto them the said Lancelot Jacques and Thomas Johnson Junr. All those several Tracts or parcels of Land following lying and being in Frederick County to wit Spring Head containing Wholly six Acres more or less Black Oak Land containing Two hundred and twenty five Acres of Land more or less Addition to Black Oak Land containing Twenty two Acres more or less Slief Gallon containing Fifty Acres of Land more or less and Killmore containing one hundred and Ninety Acres of Land more or less together with all Woods Underwoods
