Know all Men by these Presents that Joseph Alcock of Hutton Roof In the Parish of Graystock in the County of Cumberland Do lachsmith for Divers Good Causes and Considerations the hereunto moving have made ordained constituted and Appointed and by these Presents Do make ordain constitute and Apoint and in my stead and place Put and Depute John Denton of Wamell Hall in the Parish of Soboram in the said County Esq^r. my True and Lawfull Attorney Irrevocable either by himself his Substitutes or Assigns To Inter unto and Take Possession of all and Singular my messuages Lands and Tenements Plantations Commons Waists Tools Utensils Slaves Negroes Goods Chattles Hereditaments and Promises whatsoever and Wharsoever of what Nature Kind or Quality soever the same do or may consist lying and being in Maryland Virginia and Pennsylvania or any of them with their and every of their Rights Priviledges Members and Appurtenances and all and Singular other the Principles which I have right to or Interest therein or which I may Lawfully and Rightfully clayme in any part of North America and in Case he shall meet with any Obstruction from the occupiers thereof or any part thereof for ~~me~~ in my Name to Compell them thereto by a due Course of Law and also do hereby further Impower him to Sell and Dispose of all or any of the Principles when he shall have Recovered the same and Receive the Rents and Income of all or any of the said Principles and also To settle Accounts with the Occupiers thereof and To Account To no Body But To me my heirs Executors or Administrators For the Rents Profits and Produce of all and Singular the said Principles hereby Giving and Granting to my said Attorney my full Power Strength and Authority in and about the Principles and upon Receipt of any Debt Sum or Sums of Money which shall be made appear to be due and owing to the Acquittances and other Discharges for me to make and seal and Deliver and all and Every other Act and Thing goodfull to be Done in or about the Principles for the Recovery of any such Sum or Sums of Money afores^d. for me and in my Name to do execute and perform as Largely and Amply in Every respect as I could do if I were personally present hereby Revoking by these Presents all former Powers Rattifying and Holding Firm and Valid all and whatsoever my said Attorney or his Substitutes shall Lawfully do or Cause to be Done in and about the Principles by virtue of these Presents In Witness whereof I the said Joseph Alcock have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty third Day of March in the eight Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord King George the third and the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight Signed Sealed and Delivered being first Legally Stampd in the presence of us
