Esq; my True and Lawfull Attorney Irrevocable either by himself his Substitutes or
Assigns To Inter into and Take Possession of all and Singular my Possuages Lands
and Tenements Plantations Commons Waists Tools Utensils Slaves Negros Goods Chattels
Hereditaments and Promises whatsoever and wheresoever of what Nature Kind or
Quality soever the same do or may consist lying and being in Maryland Virginia and
Pennsylvania or any of them with their and every of their Rights Privileges Members
and Appurtenances and all and Singular other the Principals which I have aught to or
Intend therein or which I may lawfully and Rightfully claime in any part of
North America and in Cairo he shall meet with any obstruction from the occupiers
thereof or any part thereof for to and in my Name to Compel them thereto by a due Course
of Law and also do hereby further Empower him to Sell and Dispose off all or
any of the Principals when he shall have Recovered the same and Receive the Rents
and Income of all or any of the said Principals and also To Settle Accounts with
the Occupiers thereof and To Account To no Body But to me my heirs
Executors or Administrators for the Rents Profits and Produce off all and
Singular the said Principals hereby Giving and Granting to my said Attorney
my full Power Strength and Authority in and about the said Principals and upon
Recept off any Debt Sum or Sums of Money which shall be made appear to be due
and owing to me Acquittances and other Discharges for me to make and Seal and
Deliver and all and Every other Act and Thing needfull to be Done in or about
the said Principals for the Recovery of any such Sum or Sums of Money aforesd for
me and in my Name to do execute and Perform as largely and Amply in
