This Indenture made this twenty seventh Day of April Seventeen hundred and Sixty two Between Evan Sholby of Frederick County Gentleman of the one part and Lancelot Jaques and Thomas Johnson junior of the City of Annapolis of the other part Witness that the said Evan Sholby in Compliance with a former Agreement made between him and the said Lancelot Jaques and Thomas Johnson junr and also for and in Consideration of ten Shillings Sterling in hand paid by the said Lancelot Jaques and Thomas Johnson Junior there Recet Wherof he doth hereby Acknowledge and Wherof and therefrom doth Acquit and discharge the said Lancelot Jaques and Thomas Johnson junr their Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns and every of them by those Presents he hath given granted bargained sold aliened released enfeoffed and confirmed And by those Presents doth give grant bargain sole alienation enfeoff and conform unto them the said Lancelot Jaques and Thomas Johnson Junr all that Part of a Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in Frederick County aforesaid called the Runway on the Mountain of Wales granted and confirmed to him the said Evan Sholby containing in the whole Nine thousand eight hundred and Sixty Acres of Land which is contained within the following Lines to wit Beginning at the end of fifty two Paces on the two hundred and forty fifth Line of the said whole Tract and running with that and the other Outlines thereof to the end of the two hundred and forty ninth Line of the said whole Tract then with the Line of the Land conveyed by the said Evan Sholby to Samuel Chase until it intersects the two hundred and fifty fifth Line of the said whole Tract then with that and the other outlines thereof to the end of the two hundred and Sixty first Line of the said whole Tract then with the Lines of that part of the said Tract conveyed by the said Evan Sholby to Peter Pinkley unto the end of One hundred and nine Paces on the back Line being the longest Line of the same part then by a Line drawn to the end of eighty Paces on the two hundred and eightieth Line of the said whole Tract and from thence by a straight Line to the Beginning of the said Part hereby intended to be conveyed containing five hundred and Ninety four Acres more or less Together with all houses
