x<sup>d</sup> This Indenture Made this seventh Day of September in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and sixty eight Between Robert Bromwell of Dorchester County in the Province of Maryland of the one part and Thomas Linticum of Ann Arundell County and Province aforesaid of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Robert Bromwell for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Pounds Current Money in Dollars at seven Shillings and Six Pence each and Pistoles at Twenty seven Shillings each to him in hand Paid by the said Thomas Linticum the receipt whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge and thereof and of every Part and Parcel thereof do Acquit and Discharge the said Thomas Linticum his Executors Administrators former by these presents hath given granted Bargained sold Alienated Released Infeoffed and Confirmed and by these Presents Doth Give Grant Bargain Sell Alien Release Infeoff and confirm unto the said Thomas Linticum his Heirs and Assigns forever all that Tract or Parcel of Land lying in Dorchester County called (Nochester)
