This Indenture made the fourteenth Day of August in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Eight Between Abraham Mitchell of the City of Philadelphia in the Province of Pennsylvania Merchant and Sarah his wife of the One Park and Richard Neave of the City of London Merchant of the Other Park Whereas the said Abraham Mitchell by a certain Bond or Writing Obligatory under his hand and Seal duly Executed bearing even date herewith stands Bound unto the said Richard Neave his Executors Administrators and Assigns in the sum of three thousand six hundred and Fifty Pounds Nine Shillings and Two Pence Sterling Money of Great Britain conditioned for the Payment of One Thousand eight Hundred and Twenty five Pounds four Shillings and Eight Pence like Money unto the said Richard Neave his Executors Administrators and Assigns in Four Equal Yearly Payments that is to say the sum of Four hundred and Fifty five Pounds Six Shillings and two Pence on the first Day of May which shall be in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Nine Together with Lawful Interest for the same the further sum of four hundred and Fifty five Pounds Six Shillings and two Pence on the first day of May which shall be in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty together with Lawful Interest for the same the further sum of four hundred and Fifty six Pounds Six Shillings and two Pence on the first Day of May which shall be in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty One together with Lawful Interest for the same
