

thousand Seven hundred and Sixty nine between Martha Roundell John Fox
and Sarah his Wife Benjamin Skinner and Henrietta his Wife and Mary
Smith which said Martha Sarah Mary and Henrietta were the Daughters
of Mary Smith of Prince Georges deceased of the one part and William Hall
of Elbridge in Ann Arundel County Merchant of the other part Witnesseth
that the said Martha Roundell John Fox and Sarah his Wife Benjamin
Skinner and Henrietta his Wife and Mary Smith for and in consideration
of the sum of One hundred and forty Pounds Sterling Money to them in
hand paid at or before the sealing and Delivery of these presents
the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said William Hall
his Executors and Administrators thereof and therfrom fully Acquitted
and discharged have given granted Bargained Sold Remised released and
confirmed and by these presents do Give Grant Bargain Sell Release
and Confirm unto him the said William Hall his heirs and Assigns all that
Tract or parcell of Land called Batchelors Choice lying and being in
Ann Arundel County containing One hundred Acres and also all that part
of a Tract of Land called Hopkins Choice lying and being in said County
formerly belonging to Henry Hall of James Parish Maryland and by him
