 Premises with their and Each of their Appurtenances and the said several Negroes Respective-
 ly called Jack Lincoln from Hannah Nancy Rose Jack Emanuel Hannah and Dinah unto
 the said Charles Carroll his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns forever under a
 Proviso and Condition Nevertheless that if the said Henry Baker and Nathan Baker their
 and each of their Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns should well and truly pay
 or Cause to be paid unto the said Charles Carroll his ^{Heirs} Executors Administrators or Assigns
 the full sum of three hundred Pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain an accountado before
 the first Day of April which ^{should} be in the year of our Lord Christ Seventeen hundred and fifty

 the said Charles Carroll Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Charles
 Carroll for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and twenty two Pounds
 Seventeen Shillings and Six Pence Sterling Money of Great Britain to him in hand
 paid by the said Edward Mitchell the receipt whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge
 and therefrom doth acquit the said Edward Mitchell his heirs Executors Administrat-
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
