X^o Maryland This Indenture made this twenty fourth Day of November Domina One Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty nine Between Samuel Mansell of Frederick County and Province of Maryland Merchant of the one part & Benjamin Gapaway of Ann Arundel County and Province aforesaid Planter of the other Part Witnesseth that whereas the said Samuel Mansell did by his Indenture bearing Date the third Day of June Domina One Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Eight for the Consideration hereafter expressed make over and convey unto him the said Benjamin Gapaway his heirs and Assigns forever all him the said Samuel Mansells Right title Claim ^{and} interest of a certain tract or parcel of Land being in the said Deed erroneously called Lock Sharps but properly call'd Windsor Forest Preference being had to the said Deed will more fully and Largely appear Now This Indenture Witnesseth that the said Samuel Mansell in Order to confirm the right of the said Land that was in the aforesaid Deed bargained and sold or therein intended to be bargained and sold for the sum of Forty two pounds and Ten Pence being the Consideration being expressed in the above recited Deed which said Sum the said Samuel Mansell doth hereby Acknowledge the receipt Hath given granted bargained sold Alien'd Enfeoffed and confirmed & by these Presents doth fully clearly & Absolutely give grant Bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Benjamin Gapaway his heirs and Assigns forever Part of a tract or parcel of Land called Windsor Forest as hereafter Described lying and being in Ann Arundel County on the Drafts of Plummers Branch Beginning for the same at a Bounded White Oak and Maple being the beginning Trees of the whole Runway called Windsor Forest running thence North Eighty two degrees East
