Jonathan Pinkney his Executors Administrators and Assigns all my Right Title

of Land whereon the same is now Built and all and singular the Buildings  
Houses out Houses and Appurtenances to the same belonging<sup>as expressed</sup> in a Lease this day  
granted to me by Elizabeth Bondley of the City of Annapolis reference unto the

Heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these  
Presents Sealed with our Seals and dated this Twenty third day of  
December Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and sixty Nine  
The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound John  
Clapham whilst he shall continue in the Office of Commissioner for emitting  
Bills of Credit shall well and faithfully observe and execute the Trust reposed  
in him by the Act of Assembly of this Province Entitled an Act for Emitting  
Bills of Credit and other purposes therein mentioned according to the true Intent  
and meaning thereof Then the above Obligation to be Void and of none Effect  
otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue.
