 by Indenture of Bargain and Sale bearing date on or about the Ninth day of February
 which was in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and fifty eight
 and made between the said Samuel Beall of the one part and the above named
 Daniel Dulany of the other part he the said Samuel Beall for the Considerations
 therein mentioned did give grant Bargain sell Alien release and confirm unto
 the said Daniel Dulany his Heirs and Assigns all that Tract or Parcel of Land
 the Dwelling Plantation of the said Samuel Beall being part of Charles and
 William and containing Three Hundred and Twenty two Acres lying in
 Frederick County aforesaid And also all his part of a Tract of Land called
 Benjamin lying and being in the same County containing one Hundred and
 thirty nine Acres was the same more or less and also all that part or parcel of a
 Tract of Land called the Addition to Mill Seat belonging to the said Samuel
 Beall containing two hundred and Seventy five Acres and lying in Frederick
 County aforesaid To Hold the said Several Tracts of Land unto the said
