X^d This Indenture made the second Day of Aprill in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and Seventy Between Samuel Owings Junr of Baltimore County and Province of Maryland of the one part and Anthony Slavelly of Frederick County and said Province of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Owings Junr for and in consideration of the Sum of Fifty eight Pounds Currant Money to him in hand paid by the said Anthony Slavelly the receipt of which the said Samuel Owings Junr doth hereby Acknowledge and himself to be therewith fully satisfied contented & paid Hath given granted Bargain'd sold Alien'd Infeoffed and confirmed and by these Presents doth give grant Bargain Sell Alien Infeoff and confirm unto him the said Anthony Slavelly his Heirs & Assigns forever all that part of a Tract or Parcel of Land called the Resurvey on Owings place lying and being in Frederick County aforesaid which is contain'd within the following Metes and Bounds courses & Distances Viz^t Beginning the part hereby bargain'd and sold at the end of the second line of a Tract of Land called Michael Such & running thence West one Hundred sixty Perches South forty perches North Eighty one West forty six Perches North Ninety Perches South Eighty eight East two Hundred and Thirty four Perches and then by a Direct line to the Beginning containing Eighty three Acres of Land

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
