This Indenture made the Thirtieth day of March in the Year of our Lord seventeen Hundred and seventy Between Thomas Jennings of the City of Annapolis of the first part Mary Waymon of Anne Arundel County Widow of Edmond Waymon late of the said County deceased of the Second part and Edmond Waymon of Anne Arundel County Eldest Son of the said Mary Waymon and Edmond Waymon of the third part Witnesseth that the said Mary Waymon for the barring all Estates tail and Remainders over of and in the Land with the Appurtenances herein after mentioned and Described and for and in Consideration of the Sum of five shillings Sterling to her in hand paid by the said Edmond Waymon Party hereto the receipt whereof she doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and of every part thereof Doth acquit and Discharge the said Edmond Waymon by these Presents and for divers other good Causes and Considerations her the said Mary Waymon thereunto moving Hath granted bargained and Sold and by these Presents Doth grant bargain and Sell unto the said Edmond Waymon his Heirs and Assigns All that Tract of Land called (Dewals Range) (Lying)
