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to my own use (except my Salary from my principal) any fee or reward  
whatsoever for any service I shall do as Clerk of the said Office. And also  
that in making out the Office fees I will not willingly or unwillingly charge  
other or higher fees than limited by the Act entitled an Act for amending  
the Staple of Tobacco for preventing Frauds in his Majestys Customs and for
