This Indenture Made this Second Day of June in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand Seven hundred and Sixty six Between John Brice Junior of the City of Annapolis in the Province of Maryland Gentleman of the one part and John Brice of the City aforesaid Esquire of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Brice Junior for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said John Brice Esquire the Receipt Whereof he the said John Brice Junior doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed And by these Presents he the said John Brice Junior for himself and his Heirs Doth give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said John Brice Esquire his Heirs and assigns all the Lands lying in Cecil County in the Province aforesaid which lately purchased of and from the said John Brice Esquire and Sarah his wife and which are called and known by the Names of Part of Friesby's Prime (Choice)
