This Indenture made this Second Day of June in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty six Between Thomas Sparrow of Annapolis in Annapurdel County Silversmith Son and Heir at Law of Thomas Sparrow late of the same place deceased on the one Part and Daniel Dulany of Annapolis Barristor at Law on the other Part witnesseth that the aforesaid Thomas Sparrow for and in Consideration of the sum of Seventy Pounds current money to him in hand paid by the said Daniel Dulany the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold released & confirmed by these Presents doth give grant bargain Well release and Confirm unto the said Daniel Dulany his Heirs & assigns forever to & for his & their proper use and behoof all that tract or Parcel of Land with the Appurtenances in Frederick County called Sparrows Request containing one Hundred Acres by Estimation and all the Right Title Interest & Estate of the said Thomas Sparrow in and to the said whole Tract and every part and parcel thereof In witness whereof the said Thomas Sparrow hath hereto affixed his Hand and seal the Day & Year aforesaid
