

The heading for the tax lists has been prepared with a view to the insertion of whatever tends to distinguish and identify the property charged with taxes for the satisfaction of the individuals who may desire to inspect them. It is not expected however that the columns can in any case be filled but so far as the records furnish information for the purpose it should be done.

The headings pasted on the cover is intended to apply to the several pages of the book, by turning it outwards as occasion requires, in case the Surveyor should find it too laborious a task to put a similar heading to every page. The first folio of the book is headed and ruled by way of example the whole of it must be ruled in the same manner except that in the case above supposed the drop ruling will be omitted. The space between the names should be regulated by their number so as to insure sufficient room for the whole.
