

I do hereby certify that the foregoing General List ^{of Taxes} amounting to Six thousand four hundred and ninety one Dollars and twenty five Cents, ~ and payable on Dwelling Houses Lands and Slaves in the sixth Collection District of the State of Maryland, under and in virtue of the Act of Congress of July 11th 1798 To and collect a direct Tax within the United States, is truly and correctly prepared and stated, agreeably to Valuations, Enumerations and Appraisements made under the Authority of the Act of July 9th 1798 To provide for the Valuation of Lands and Dwelling Houses and the Enumeration of Slaves within the United States and the Act of July 11th 1798 above recited; - and that the same contains a full account of the Taxes payable as aforesaid, with the exceptions of those which are specified in a Supplementary List amounting to Six hundred and thirteen Dollars and thirty nine Cents, ~ to which, with a full reference to this General List, Certificate similar to the present is this day affixed.
