merations and Appraisements made under the Authority of the Act of July 9th 1798 "To provide for the Valua-
tion of Lands and Dwelling Houses and the Enumeration of Slaves within the United States," and the Act of
July 14th 1798 above recited, - and that it contains an account of all Taxes payable as aforesaid, which are
not comprehended in a General Tax List prepared for the said Collection District, and amounting to Fif-
teen hundred and Thirteen Dollars and - - to which, with a like refer-
