It being represented, that the original crew of the Private armed Venezuelan Schooner called the Coroncy of which William Saunders is master or Commander have left the said vessel, and that her present situation requires repairs which can only be made in a northern Port at this season: These are therefore to permit the said Schooner Coroncy to leave this Port, for Baltimore in the State of Maryland, with a crew not exceeding six seamen exclusive of her Commander and first Officer, for the purpose aforesaid.
