

Baltimore County vs.

Before me one of the Justices of the peace  
for said County, James Mills Late master  
of the Sloop Called the Huldrick, of Baltimore,  
who being sworn on the Holy Evangelis of Almighty  
god doth depose & say — That he sailed from  
this Port of Baltimore for Gonaires in Island of  
Saint Domingo, onboard of the said Sloop on  
or about the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1797 — That  
on or about the seventh day of April following  
within about three Leagues of the Port of Gonaires  
he was Captured and Conducted, with the said  
Sloop, to port Aspinwall by the British armed  
Ship Called the Rettler Richard Allen Command  
er, in Conjunction with the British armed  
Schooner Called the Maria Antonette Commanded  
by Richard Horley; and That the said Sloop  
was there detained, out of the Custody & Charge  
of this Deponent until about the twelfth  
day of July last past, when the said Sloop  
and the principal part of the cargo <sup>were</sup> adjudged  
Legal prize to the Captors aforesaid —  
and this Deponent farther saith that he  
was deprived of the Sloop's Register and  
all her other papers by the Captors aforesd,  
and that he hath not since recovered the  
said register or any of the other papers,  
and farther this deponent saith not
