

Memorandums

Received from Willis Green a Patent for 4000 Acres of Land in Fayette County

Also one Patent for 1500 Acres lying in Nelson County on Pleasant Run
& Cartwrights Creek, prime Land in these remains 1000 Acres to be
accounted for by Green

Mr. Neilson entered in the Registers Office near Danville 3 Certificates of
Survey, Vizt 330 Acres, 520 & 962 Acres, Situation the South Side of Kentucky
near Dunning's Lick. The Plats that Mr. Neilson received from Shepherd are also
on the South Side of Kentucky.

Mr. Neilson received from Willis Green a Deed for the 1500 Acre tract patented
(the Patent is here) and a Deed for the 1500 Acres. These Deeds were left
with Mr. Stephen Cornsby Attorney at Danville, to get them recorded.

Mr. Neilson left Orders with Willis Green to deliver the Patent for the other
tract of 1000 Acres as soon as he got it to Mr. Cornsby, and to execute
a Deed for the same, and deliver it to Mr. Cornsby.

Mr. Neilson left Grayson & Co's Bond for 6000 Acres of Land in the hands
of Mr. Cornsby, with Orders to sue for the same, this Business will be con-
ducted by Mr. Sebastian.

The 10 Lots in Louisville purchased by Mr. Neilson & Co. were not yet paid
for, but were left under the care of Mr. Sebastian to have Deeds executed
for them, with Orders to pay for them when he got money.
The whole cost about £30 of Currency.

* The Patent for the 1500 Acres to Green I suppose must be lost as it's
not amongst the Papers.
