

Memorandum

Received from Willis Green a Patent for 4000 Acres of Land in Fayette County  
also One Patent for 1500 Acres lying in Nelson County on Pheasant Run  
of Cartwright's Creek, prime land or there remains 1000 acres to be —  
accounted for by Green

N. Nelson listed in the Register's Office near Danville 3 Certificates of  
Surveys. vizt 380 acres, 520 & 962 acres, Situation the South Side of Kentucky  
near Dumming's Lick. The Plots that N. Nelson received from Shepherd are also  
on the south side of Kentucky

N. Nelson received from Willis Green a deed for the 4000 Acre tract presented  
(The Patent is here) and a deed for the 1500 acres. Those Deeds were left —  
with Mr. Stephen Ormsby Attorney at Danville to get them Recorded

N. Nelson left orders with Willis Green to deliver the Patent for the other  
tract of 1000 acres as soon as he got it to Mr. Ormsby, and to execute  
a Deed for the same, and deliver it to Mr. Ormsby —

N. Nelson left Grayson & Co's Bond for 6000 acres of land in the hands  
of Mr. Ormsby, with Orders to sue for the same, This Business will be con-  
ducted by Mr. Sebastian —

The 10 lots in Louisville purchased by N. Nelson were not yet paid  
for, but were left under the care of Mr. Sebastian to have Deeds Executed  
for them, with Orders to pay for them when he got money —  
The whole cost about £30 of Currency

\* The Patent for the 1500 acres to Green I suppose must be lost as it
