 8 for the application of such certificates, in like manner, and under
 9 the same regulations, as heretofore they have accounted with the
 10 supervisors.

1 Sec. 8. *And be it further enacted*, That for preparing and issu-
 2 ing the certificates the collectors ~~or surveyors~~ performing that
 3 duty, shall be entitled to, and receive the same compensation, as
 4 heretofore has been allowed to the supervisors, respectively.

1 Sec. 8. *And be it further enacted*, That all persons who shall
 2 have any blank vellum, parchment or paper, which has been
 3 stamped, and on which a duty has been paid, to the use of the
 4 government, at the time when a stamp ceases to be required,
 5 in consequence of this act, shall be entitled to receive from the
 6 collectors of the customs of the respective districts, the value
 7 of the said stamps, after deducting, in all cases, seven and a half
 8 per cent. and the said collectors are hereby authorized to pay
 9 the same. *Provided*, the said blank vellum, parchment or paper,
 10 be presented within four months after the expiration of the time
 11 that stamps are required.

Sec. 9. ~~and further enacted~~, That all persons who shall on or after the thirtieth day of June next, have any blank vellum, parchment or paper, which has been stamped by the superintendent of stamps and counterstamped by the commissioner of the revenue of the customs or other revenue officer in the respective states or districts as may be designated for that purpose by the Secretary of the Treasury, the value of the said stamp, after deducting in all cases, seven and a half per cent, and the said officers are hereby authorized to pay the same. Provided, the said blank vellum, parchment or paper, be presented within four months after the thirtieth day of June next.
