And Israel Robinson a Deputy Surveyor of the District of Penobscot having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is seventy two feet, four inches, her breadth her depth seven feet eleven and one half inches twenty one feet, six inches, and that she measures One hundred eight & ²⁸/₁₀₀ Tons, that she is a square sterned Schooner has no Galleries and no figure head.
