 Honors doe make our humble Address to the Worshipfull Court to enter a caveat
 against the said proceedings that the bounds of said Land may be better
 ascertained & if no bounded tree can be found to begin the said Land where the Record
 expresseth it that by another referency of said Land a jury may find a point or
 point to begin at about the place where the Record expresseth the said Land to begin
 and as in duty bound your petitioners shall ever pray &c.

The which petition being read by the Court heard & maturely considered
 It was thereupon ordered that the said petitioners have a Warrant of resurvey
 & a venire for a Jury according to their petition
 Jⁿ. Dowdall

 aff^d into your wife & tender considerations and allow her what your Worships shall
 think meet & convenient for her support & maintenance untill it shall please God
 to restore her to her former health & limbs againe & as in duty bound your petitioners
 shall ever pray &c. The which petition being read by the Court
 Duly considered It was ordered that W^m. Robinson having possession of the said
 Katherine as his now desires that he have allowed her five hundred pounds of
 Tob. out of the County within this yeare
 Jⁿ. Dowdall
