John Bone having acknowledged a crime was sent by the said Justice to the Sheriff of this County & committed into his custody until this Court who now appearing being againe questioned about the premises declared that he is altogether innocent of the crime & that those that committed the fact were Tailors belonging to the said Shipps he belonged to after the offence was found out that they threatened to run away & leave the Shipps but he having a regard for the owners & Tailors feared the voyage should suffer & promised them if they would stay he would take the matter upon himselfe

Which being considered of by the Court they of opinion that he had declared the truth It was considered that the punishment was for such a crime to be remitted that the said John Bone did pay twenty Shillings forrunt monny of this Province for the four fold of the good acquiescing that he is declared a

The Appersand Doquett called on
 Borsgrind Browne Comand was given to the Sheriff of Kent County the 18 day of June anno Domini 1701 that he take Edward Rush if found in his bailiwick & him safe keep so that he have his body before our Justice at a Court to be hold for said County the 4th day of August next to answer unto Borsgrind Browne of a plea of Trespass upon the Case - At which next Court viz. the 26. day of Aug. anno Domini 1701 the Day of returne of writt came Elias King high Sheriff of said County & made returne therof in these words viz. *espe corpus*

The cause was continued until this present Court & was heard at this day viz. the 23rd day of Sep. Anno Domini 1701 came the said Defend. Edw. Rush & confessed Judgment for this Act following viz. M^r. Edward Rush & D. Anno 1699
