

November Court 1700

Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County, 27. day of August Anno Dom. 1700 that he should James Daulton of the said County Plaintiff if he should find in his bailment of him safe keep so that he should have his body before his Majesty's Justices at the next Court sitting to answer unto Thomas Bulcock of the County of Middlesex upon a writ

On which Day came Elias King high Sheriff of said County, Day after the return of said writ and made return thereof in these words viz. *expi corpus* of Elias King Sheriff. And the which cause was continued from Court to Court until the 28. day of November Anno Dom. 1700 and now the said Cause standing for Trial by the Plaintiff Daulton against James Daulton of said County Plaintiff stands attached to answer unto Thomas Bulcock of the County of Middlesex upon a writ

And whereas upon the said Thomas Bulcock by Richard Maitlin his Attorney says that whereas the said James Daulton Plaintiff was within the Jurisdiction of this Court, by the 27. day of August Anno Dom. 1699 by his certain Script or bill which Daulton by the said day of August 1699 brought and oblige himself his heirs Ex. or Adm. to pay unto the said Thomas Bulcock or order of him the sum of five hundred and twenty pounds of good merchantable Gold in fee upon demand in consideration that the said James Daulton upon himself the said Thomas Bulcock faithfully did promise that he the said James Daulton when thereunto required by the said Thomas Bulcock or order of him the sum of five hundred and twenty pounds of good merchantable Gold according to the said James Daulton's bill or Script shall not paid at the offer demanded but the said James Daulton to pay both damages and still collect and refuse to pay the said Thomas Bulcock one thousand pounds of Gold and thereupon he brings this suit and the said Thomas Bulcock Plaintiff by his said Attorney prays that the said Defendant James Daulton might be compelled to answer to his Debt, who being called came not nor any for him but being defaulted wherefore Judgment was awarded for the said sum of five hundred and twenty pounds of Gold

Therefore it is considered by the Court here viz. 28. day of November Anno Dom. 1700 that the said Plaintiff Thomas Bulcock do recover from the said Defendant James Daulton as well the sum of five hundred and twenty pounds of Gold Debt as also the sum of two hundred twenty nine pounds of Gold cost of said and of said James Daulton in money

At which Court viz. 25. day of March Anno Dom. 1700 also by the 25. day of June Anno Dom. 1700 the said writ came Elias King high Sheriff of said County and made return of said writ in these words viz. *Non Est Invenius*

Command was likewise given to the Sheriff of Kent County, 27. day of August Anno Dom. 1700 that he should James Donabant alias Dilus James Donabant of the County of Kent and Province of Maryland Plaintiff if found in his bailment of him safe keep so that he should have his body before his Majesty's Justices at the next Court sitting to answer unto Flower Walker of old England Tenant and workman of the said Plaintiff James Donabant the sum of five hundred forty five pounds of Gold in fee

On which said Day viz. 27. day of August Anno Dom. 1700 the said writ came Elias King high Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words viz. *expi corpus* of Elias King Sheriff. And the which cause was continued until the 28. day of November Anno Dom. 1700 and now the said Cause standing for Trial by the Plaintiff Flower Walker against James Donabant Plaintiff stands attached to answer unto the said Defendant James Donabant and the said Defendant James Donabant by Richard Maitlin his Attorney and the said Defendant James Donabant being defaulted wherefore Judgment was awarded for the said sum of five hundred and forty five pounds of Gold Debt as also the sum of three hundred twenty seven pounds of Gold cost of said and of said James Donabant in money
