

The said at the rate of price of ninety pounds of gold of each sum which in whole
 amounts in the whole to the sum of ten hundred and seventy pounds of gold. in consider-
 ation whereof the said Hannah when she was upon her first apurment and unto the said John
 faithfully promised that the said Hannah when her servants afterwards required
 the said sum of 270^l of gold. unto the said John she would pay well & truly, and altho
 the said John did allow unto the said Hannah the sum of fifty pounds of gold. by way
 of abatement by reason that the three silms of Casque was not completely finished
 yet as to the residue being 220^l of gold. the said Hannah when she and the said Nathan and
 Hannah after espousals between them celebrated little regarding the said promise
 & assumption of the said Hannah which she was to do as she made but plotting
 contriving & fraudulently intending the said John in that behalf craftily &
 subtilly to deceive & defraud the said Hannah when she was to pay the said
 Hannah after espousals between them celebrated the said residue of
 the said 270^l of gold. to the said John they have not as yet paid nor either of them hath
 paid altho the said Hannah when she was by the said John often her servants required
 and the said Nathan and Hannah in like manner after espousals between them
 celebrated by the said John have been her servants required whereupon the said John
 says that he is damnified and hath damage to the value of 400^l of gold. and there-
 on he brings this Suetor.

 two hundred & seven pounds of gold. Debt as also the sum of five hundred &
 nineteen pounds of gold. Debt of the said Defendants in Merit & the Costs
 Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County the 25 day of June Anno Domini 1701 that he
 take Hugh Marsh if found in his Bailiwick and him safe keep so that he have his
 body before
