

Notem. Court 1701
Wherefore it is configured by Court here viz. this 27 day of Notem. Anno Dom. 1701 that the said Nathan Comyns Plaintiff do recover from the said Defendant Hugh Marph ab well two gunns well fixed Stock & Lock as also the value of three hundred and eleven pounds of Gold. cost of Suits of the said Hugh in mercy and

In Dowdall the said David Marph comes into Court & swears that he has attended as an Evidence for the said Plaintiff at Thomas Griffiths & Spaid of three days and

David Marph being bound by Recognizance to make his personall appearance here at this Court & good behaviour in the mean time now appeared & cleared by the same

Vincent Hemsted of Salcott County comes into Court & prors an Act at Edward Smith late of Kent County Deceased for the sum of two thousand three hundred pounds of Gold and that there is due upon said sum of Twelve hundred ninety & four pounds of Gold

Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County the 20 day of March anno Dom. 1701 that he take Lawrence Grosse if found in his bailiwick & him safe keep. So that he have his body at the next Court to be hold for said County before his Majesty's Justice to answer unto John Hyde of Aplea of trespass upon the case
At which next Court viz. the 24 day of June the day of the Return of said writt came the King high Sheriff of said County & made return thereof in the words viz. But the said Plaintiff by Richard Marklin his atty moved the Court that the said Defendant Lawrence Grosse may find Eff. bail to said Action & committed unto the Sheriff's custody untill he find bail which was granted
And ordered that the Sheriff of Kent County do take into his custody & body of the said Lawrence Grosse & him safe keep untill he find Eff. bail to said action

And the said Defendant comes into Court & brings Robert Smith Esq. along with him who affirms that the said Defendant Lawrence Grosse shall pay Condemnation if he or else he will do it for him

On which said day the said Defendant by Michael Earle his atty appeared & prayd thereof to be imparled untill the next Court which was granted him & same day was given the Plaintiff also

And now here at this day viz. the 27 day of Notem. Anno Dom. 1701 came also the said Defendant by his said atty as also the said Plaintiff by Richard Marklin his atty & the said cause standing for tryall the Plaintiff's Debit

Maryland Esq. Plaintiff of Kent County stands attached to answer unto John Hyde of Aplea of trespass upon the case

And whereupon the said John Hyde by Richard Marklin his atty complains that whereas the said John Hyde the 23 day of October Anno Dom. 1697 and at several other days since afterwards at London in the Kingdom of old England within the jurisdiction of this Court at the special instance and request of the said Lawrence and for the proper use thereof
