

Novem. Court 1701

Put a Copie of the Debt being sent along w<sup>th</sup> writt & left at the last place of the said James his abode according as the Law requires the said plaint by Richard Maucklin his Att<sup>y</sup> mover of Court that he may have Judg<sup>t</sup> which was granted him

Therefore it is considered by the Court here this day viz<sup>t</sup> the 20 day of Novem<sup>r</sup> Anno 1701 that the said plaint by the said James Thoswood Defend<sup>t</sup> as well for the sum of nine hundred & eight pounds of good Debt as also for the sum of five hundred & twenty pounds of Debt in money  
In Dowdall

Command was given to the coroner of Kent County the 25<sup>th</sup> day of Sep<sup>r</sup> Anno 1701 that he should James Thoswood of said County plantiff in his bailie in the name of the King's High Court to behold for said County to answer unto Elias King of a plea of trespass upon the case

All which noth<sup>g</sup> Court viz<sup>t</sup> the 25<sup>th</sup> day of Novem<sup>r</sup> Anno 1701 Day of the Return of said writt came Thomas Smith one of the coroners of said County and made returne thereof viz<sup>t</sup> and Put a Copie of the Debt going along w<sup>th</sup> writt was as follows  
In Dowdall

Kent Co James Thoswood of Kent County Standeth attached to answer unto Elias King of a plea of trespass upon the case

Whereupon the said Elias by Richard Maucklin his Att<sup>y</sup> complaineth that the said James Standeth justly indebted unto the said Elias in the full just sum of five hundred forty seven pounds of good as by an act made in Court ready to be proved may appear No debts left the said James the said sum of five hundred forty seven pounds of good nor any part thereof unto the said Elias hath paid but the said James to pay hath refused altho' often therunto required whereupon the said Elias saith he is damaged one thousand pounds of good. Whereupon being thus said as follows

Therefore it is considered by the Court further this day viz<sup>t</sup> the 20 day of Novem<sup>r</sup> Anno 1701 that the said plaint by the said Elias King have Attachm<sup>t</sup> & the goods shall be doct right or credits of the said Defend<sup>t</sup> James Thoswood as well for the sum of five hundred forty seven pounds of good Debt as also for the sum of five hundred & twenty pounds of good Debt in money  
In Dowdall
