 at the instans request of the said Edward Rush in the year 1699 within the jurisdiction of
 had credited a certain James Broadley with the sum of fifteen pounds of £. and also at
 the Instans request of the said Edward Rush in the year 1699 within the jurisdiction of
 credited a certain Joseph Hopkins with the sum of five hundred pounds of £. and also at
 the Instans request of the said Edward Rush in the year 1699 and within the jurisdiction of
 credited a certain John Road with the sum of four hundred and fifty pounds of £. and also at
 the instans and request of the said Edward Rush &c. 27. day of Octo. Anno Dom. 1700 within
 Jurisdiction of the said Court had credited a certain William Seabury with the sum of Two hundred and
 Seabury pounds of £. all which goods wares Merchandises sold and delivered and several
 credits affore mentioned amount in the whole to the sum of one thousand eight hundred fifty
