

And whereupon the said Wm Burris by Richard Macklin his atty saith that whereas the said Charles Hollisworth the 29 day of Novem. Anno Dom. 1699 att Kent County within the jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bill or writing obligatory sealed with his Seale at his att. doth demand and here into Court brought whose date is the 29 day and yeares after did and himselfe his heirs Exors Adors and every of them to pay or cause to be paid unto the said Wm Burris his heirs or Successors one horse of two yeares old full dockt. at or by the first day of May next ensuing the date of the said bill or writing obligatory yet notwithstanding the said Charles Hollisworth the said horse of two yeares old full dockt. unto the said Wm according to the Tenor of the said bill altho often demanded he hath not paid but the same to pay hath denied & refused and still doth deny and refuse unjustly detained to the Damage of the said Wm 1200 of feet and hereupon he brings this Title and Macklin Esq: pleades for the said Wm Burris

And the said Defend^t by Michael Earle his atty comes and Charles Hollisworth the Defend^t by force of injury when he did and causes over of the plant Jun^r atty for the said Earle the Defend^t

The which plea being not qualified the said Michael Earle atty of the said Defend^t afterwards pleads non sum Informatus Upon which Judg^t awarded for the said Docket & cost of Suite

Therefore it is considered by the Court here viz^t the 29 day of Novem. Anno Dom. 1701 that the said Plaintiff William Burris doe recover from the said Defend^t Charles Hollisworth Jun^r as well one two yeares old horse with dockt Debt at a good & true of two hundred twenty eight pounds of good cost of Suite & the said Defend^t in Mercy

Command was given to the Sher^t of Kent County the 29 day of March Anno Dom. 1701 that he take Patrick Fraugh likewise the 29 day of March Anno Dom. 1701 that he take the said Patrick Fraugh otherwise called Patrick Fraugh the said County Merchant of good and his bailies in him take keep & see that he have his body before his Mayors Justice at the next Court to be hold for said County to answer unto John Dubois of Kent County in & for the Province of Pennsylvania Merchant of a plea that he render unto him the full Just Sum of 1000 pounds fourteen Shillings & seven pence current full Silver Money of said Province of Pennsylvania which to him he oweth & from him he unjustly detained

all which next first Court viz^t the 25 day of March Anno Dom. 1701 the day of the return of which first writ came Elias King high Sher^t of said County made returns thereof likewise came the said Sher^t the 29 day of June Anno Dom. 1701 the day of the return of the second writ and made returns thereof viz^t the said Elias King Sher^t On which said Day the said Defend^t by Richard Macklin his atty appears & prayed thereof to impart until the next Court which was granted him the said day was given to the Plaintiff likewise
