his body before his Majesty's Justices at the next Courts to be holden for said County to answer unto  
John Dubois of Kent County a Breve of Pennsylvania Merchant of as he that he render  
unto him the full & just value of seven pounds Eighteen Shillings & two pence current & full  
Silver Money of said Breve of Pennsylvania which he...

All which first next Court viz<sup>t</sup> 29 day of March Anno Domini 1701 day of return  
return of said first writt came Elias Kinghigh Sheriff of said County made return Non est  
likewise came said Elias Kinghigh Sheriff at assize 24 day of June Anno Domini 1701  
and made return being 2 day of return of said second writt, viz<sup>t</sup> copy of Elias Kinghigh  
On which day said Defendant by Richard Martin his Att<sup>y</sup> appeared & prayed thereof to  
Imparole until the next Court which was granted unto him & said writt of Plaint passed

The which cause was sent from Court to Court until this present Court and now now at this day  
viz<sup>t</sup> 29 day of Novem<sup>r</sup> Anno Domini 1701 came as aforesaid said Defendant by his Att<sup>y</sup>  
as aforesaid plant by his Att<sup>y</sup> Attorney and said cause standing for finally Plaintiff Debt  
Kent County in Maryland & Gabriel Fraugh alias Dulus Patrick Fraugh of said County

owne bill or writing obligatory sealed with his seal as his Att<sup>y</sup> doth shew here in Court  
brought whose date is the same day & year did confess himself to be owing said seven pounds  
unto said John & att<sup>y</sup> value of seven pounds eighteen Shillings & two pence which payment of all  
att<sup>y</sup> to be paid to said John his heirs & assigns or to the order of the said John & assigns to pay  
multiple to make done by said Gabriel & assigns to be paid to his heirs & assigns to pay  
att<sup>y</sup> Silver Money at the house of M<sup>r</sup> Gabriel Robinson in the City of Philadelphia in  
att<sup>y</sup> Breve of Pennsylvania at or before the 10 day of July next ensuing the date of said bill  
yet notwithstanding said Gabriel Fraugh & att<sup>y</sup> sums of 7<sup>l</sup> 18<sup>s</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> Silver Money as att<sup>y</sup>  
according to said bill unto said John Dubois he hath not paid all the said money  
as but by said bill to pay he hath denyed & refused and still doth deny & refuse and unjustly obtained  
by Damages of said John 15 - 10 - 4 Silver Money as att<sup>y</sup> and thereupon he brings this suit

Instrument as his act & deed as witness my hand and seal of the said County this 28  
day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1700 and that he saw John Brown signed as an Evidence to said  
Instrument as witness my hand & seal of the County & J<sup>n</sup> Robinson
