 At which next Court viz^t 25 day of Sep^r Anno Domⁱ 1701 the day of the return of
 said writ according to adjournment came Elias Kinghigh Sheriff of said County made
 return thereof in these words following viz^t and cop^y corpus of Elias Kinghigh Sheriff

On which said day the said Defendant in his proper person appeared & prayed the
 Imparls untill the next Court which was granted unto him & said day was given by
 A. N. Now here at this day viz^t 20 day of Novem^r Anno Domⁱ 1701 came as well the said
 Defendant in his proper person as also the said Plaintiff by Richard Macklin his Att^y and
 the said cause standing for tryall of said Debt

Kent Is Thomas Folley of Kent County Court stands attached to answer unto Edward
 Stobsonson of a plea of trespass upon the case

And whereupon the said Edward by Richard Macklin his Att^y complains that whereas the said
 Thomas Folley on the 10 day of Aprⁱ Anno Domⁱ 1701 at the place where in Kent County is in the
 session of this Court stood Justly Indebted unto the said Edward in the full & just sum of two
 pounds Ster^t money and the said Thomas being indebted so as aforesaid unto the said Edward
 Thomas did draw his certain note or Scrip^t signed with his proper name & hand of the said
 Thomas directed to a certain W^m Dowling requesting thereby the said W^m Dowling to pay to
 the said Edward Stobsonson or ord^r the said sum of two pounds Ster^t money which the said
 Thomas was indebted to the said Edward and placed the said sum to the ac^t of him the said Thomas -
 which said Note or Scrip^t is here in Court brought In consideration thereof the said Thomas
 upon himself assumed and unto the said Edward then & there faithfully promised that if in-
 case the said W^m Dowling should fail in the payment of the said two pounds Ster^t money
 unto him the said Edward Stobsonson that then he the said Thomas the said sum of two pounds
 Ster^t money unto the said Edward when he should afterwards required he would coll^r truly
 pay and the said Edward in fact faith that he did so sent the said Note or Scrip^t unto the said
 W^m Dowling requiring of the said W^m Dowling the paym^t of the said two pounds Ster^t in the said
 note contained who utterly refused the paym^t thereof yet & thereafter the said Thomas Folley his
 promise & assumption not minding nor regarding nor in any manner weighing but plotting
 contriving & fraudulently intending the said Edward in that behalf craftily & subtilly to
 receive & defraud the said sum of two pounds Ster^t money according to his promise &
 assumption altho' often afterwards demanded unto the said Edward Stobsonson & said Thomas
 Folley as yet hath not paid but the said sum to him to pay hitherto hath denyed and as yet the said sum to
 him
