said justly Indebted unto our said Sovereigne Lord King his brother Sauford Esq^r in full
and just sume of Four pounds sterl to be paid upon his lands & tenementes good challes
and just sume of Forty pounds sterl to be paid upon his lands & tenementes good challes
in case the said John Bennett doth not make his personall appearance at the next Court to be held for
this County in the mean time to be of good behaviour and appearance to all his Majestys subjects
Subiects wherewith they are contented -

Elizabeth Peterson being committed into the Sheriff's custody untill she find sufficient security for her
personall appearance at the next Court to be held for this County and good behaviour in the mean time
now appears -

The John Bonder her Surety doth acknowledge her
selfe to owe the said Elizabeth Peterson and acknowledge her
indebted unto our Sovereigne Lord King William the Third Esq^r his brother
or Sauford in the sume of only pounds sterl to be paid upon her goods & chattels lands & tenement
in case the said Elizabeth doth not make her personall appearance at the next Court to be of good
behaviour & appearance to his Majestys subjects in the mean while he himselfe came In
Bonder Surety for the said Elizabeth Peterson and acknowledging himselfe to owe the said justly
Indebted unto our said Sovereigne Lord King William the Third Esq^r his brother and Sauford in full
and just sume of Twenty pounds sterl to be paid as aforesaid concurred as aforesaid wherewith they
are contented
