having issued and J^r Hynson now makes returns of said writ attached in the hands of J^r Hynson
brought and also made known before J^r Hynson & Charles Hollingsworth Junr. & said J^r.
that he do appear to do as by J^r Hynson's process Jam. Jorum & J^r Hynson
But said Defendant by Michael Earle his atty. moves this Court that he may have liberty
to appear to J^r Original action, But said Plaintiff Richard Jorum by Richard Macklin
his atty. prayed that J^r said Defendant John Dubois may put in sufficient Security for
payment of condemnation if cast which was by J^r Court granted unto him

But Michael Earle assumed here in open Court that J^r said J^r Dubois shall pay

will do it for him

Ordered by this Court that Hugh Marsh be personally appears at J^r Court being along
with him his son John Marsh that it may evidently appears to J^r Court what his said
son be yet a fugitive or no
