That a Copy of a Decree being sent along with the Court and Bench according to Act of
Parliament in such Cases made & provided was as follows viz

Maryland & Thomas Tolly of Kent County sent was summoned to answer unto John
Alkoy & Company Merchants of Apsalwick his ransom unto them or their Heirs
of the sum of Eight thousand two hundred pounds of Merchants
Goods in Cask which to them he oweth from them he unjustly detaineth

And whereupon said In the by Richard Markler Sheriff of the County of Kent
whereas said Thomas Tolly by 13 Day of May 1699 at Kent County within the Jurisdiction
of this Court & his certain writing obligatory took to the said Tolly of him said Thomas
and here in Court produced whose date is by Day and Year after did bind himself his
Heirs &c. to pay unto the said John Alkoy & Company just sum of Eight thousand two
hundred pounds of good sound Merchants Goods in Cask convenient in Kent County Northward
within the County of Kent the sum of Eight thousand two hundred pounds of Goods to him the said John
Alkoy hath not paid all the often demanded but the said sum of Eight thousand two
hundred pounds of Goods to the said John Alkoy to pay which hath done and yet doth any
upon the said John Alkoy say they and Damages he have lost so the value of Sixteen thousand
pounds of Goods thereupon bring their Suits Markler Sheriff

And the said Defendant craves Copy of the Indenture of the said obligation and it is read unto him in
these words viz The Indenture of the said obligation is such that if the above named Thomas Tolly
do not as he truly pay, or cause to be paid, unto the above named John Alkoy & Company within
the space of four thousand one hundred pounds of Goods in Cask at
some convenient Landing in the County of Kent at or upon the tenth day of October next
ensuing the date hereof then this present obligation to be void of no effect otherwise to
stand and remain in full force powers &c

But the said Defendant Thomas Tolly cometh into Court in his proper person and confesseth Judgment
of the sum of one thousand four hundred sixty four pounds of Goods being the balance due a penny
said bond and cost accruing upon the said

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Plaintiff John Alkoy and Company do recover
from the said Defendant Thomas Tolly as well the sum of one thousand four hundred sixty four pounds
of Goods due as also the sum of two hundred twenty and four pounds of Goods cost of Suits and the
Thomas Tolly in Maryland

Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County by 29 day of November Anno Domini 1700 that
he take Saml Taylor of said County Inhabitant if found in his bailiwick and him safe keep so
that he have his body before his Majesty's Justices at a Court to be held for our said County
fourth Tuesday of January next to answer unto John Hawkins of Apsalwick his ransom upon the said

Which next Court being adjourned forth until the 15th day of February Anno Domini 1700
all people were committed into the Sheriff's custody until the said adjourned Court
At which next Court the 15th day of February Anno Domini 1700 the Day of
the return of the said according to adjournment James Elab King high Sheriff of said
County and made in and thence in these words viz Spi for Sab Elab King Sheriff

But the said Defendant Saml Taylor in his proper person cometh into Court and confesseth
Judgment to the said Plaintiff for the sum of seven pounds seven shillings & six pence
current money of this Province and the sum of two thousand three hundred and seven
pounds of Goods due & cost of Suits

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Plaintiff John Hawkins do
recover from the said Defendant Saml Taylor as well the sum of seven pounds seven shillings
& six pence current money of this Province as also the sum of two thousand three hundred
& seven pounds
